# Case Study: The Culture Trust, Luton

Zerogram was appointed by Culture Trust Luton, to deliver a decarbonisation roadmaps their flagship site, the Stockwood Discovery Centre. This focussed on carrying out multiple site surveys to identify quick energy cost savings measures as well as a long term investment plan to net zero operations. The roadmap identified cost savings of over £64,000 per annum and carbon reduction of approximately 68 tonnes of carbon. With the recommendations implemented, the site could reach operational net zero by 2030.


